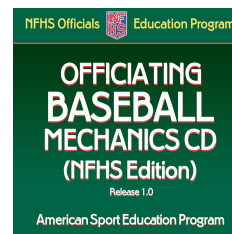
The new NFHS OFFICIATING BASEBALL METHODS online course can help you be a better baseball umpire this season!
